

iUrban Code of Conduct

iUrban is open to everyone. We are committed to providing a friendly, safe, and welcoming environment for all.

All iUrban Teen participants are expected to act in a way that will foster a safe and positive event experience for everyone during any events or programs affiliated with iUrban Teen. Participants are expected to:

- Be considerate, respectful, and collaborative.
- Refrain from demeaning, discriminatory, or harassing behavior and speech.
- Be mindful of your surroundings and of your fellow participants.
- Alert organizers if you notice a dangerous situation or someone in distress.
- Make new friends and have a great time.

Unacceptable behaviors include

- Name calling (sexually charged language, concerning sexual orientation, gender, race, religion or background.)
- Taking photos of someone without permission or recording personal conversations.
- Talking or following individuals against their will.
- Disrupting of speakers, facilitators or program participants.

These behaviors will not be tolerated. If a participant behaves unacceptably, the organizers will take any action deemed appropriate, including expulsion from the event or program.
