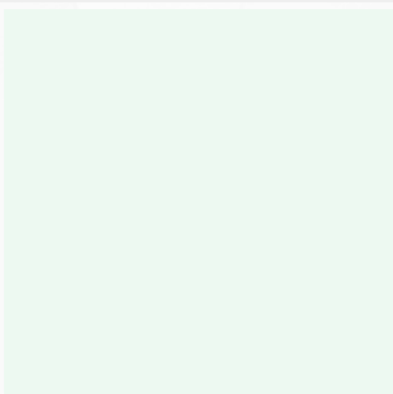

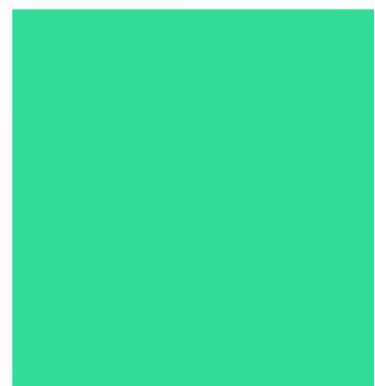
- Principals and teachers expressed appreciation for the additional support provided by fellows in the classrooms.

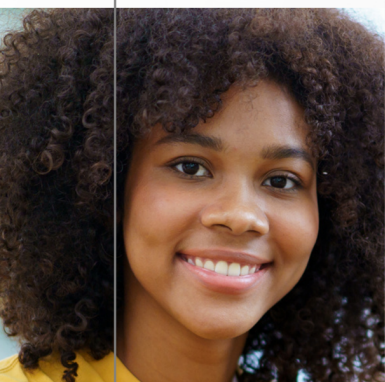

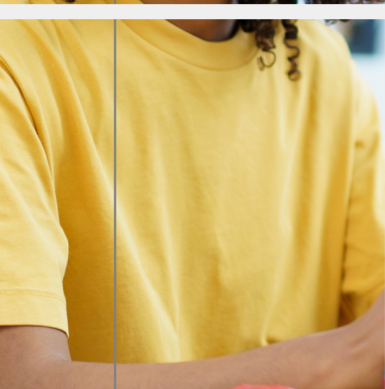

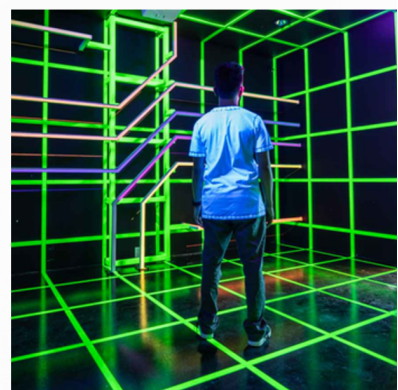
Reflecting on iUrban Teen's Houston Expansion: Empowering Youth Through STEAM Innovation

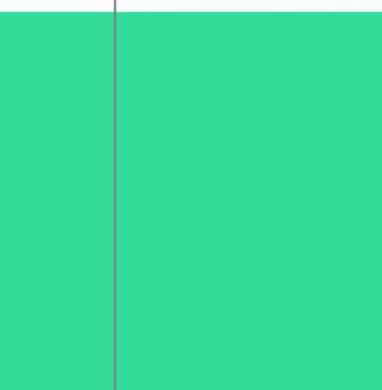
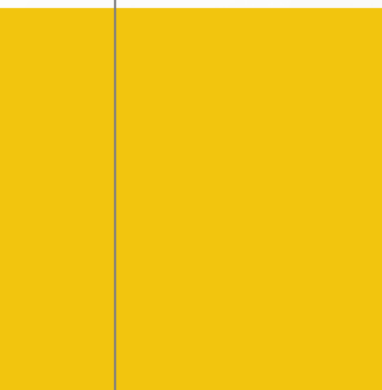
Building Tomorrow's Workforce: The Impact of iUrban Teen's iBuild Program

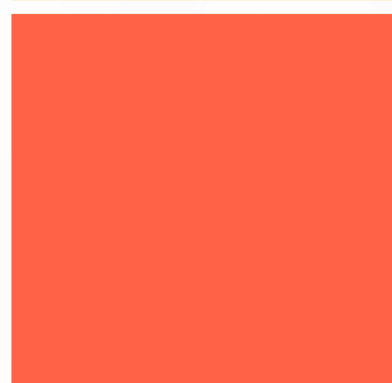

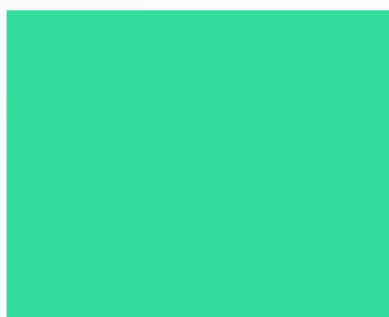
Empowering Futures: iUrban Teen and Mighty Media's Impactful STEM + Arts Tour

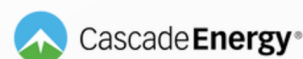
Exploring the Cosmos: iSpace 2023 Ignites Futures in Space Exploration
